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- 2. Every vehicle that hauls waste to the MCIA Transfer Station must be registered with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP). Consequently, we cannot open an account without a valid NJDEP number for your vehicle(s). TO OBTAIN A NJDEP REGISTRATION PLEASE CONTACT THE NJDEP. Also, haulers must present a valid NJDEP card to the scale master at the time of tipping.
- 3. Fill out the attached Application for a New Hauler Account and bring it to the MCIA offices. Inform the receptionist that you wish to open a hauler's account. Based upon the capacity of the vehicles(s), the type(s) of waste, and the frequency of trips to the transfer station, a deposit amount will be computed. The minimum amount is \$250.00. Cash is NOT accepted at any time. Company check, money order and certified bank checks are acceptable forms of payment. All returned checks will be subject to a returned check fee.
- 4. When dumping at the transfer station, you must submit a "Waste Origin and Disposal Form" at the scale house FOR EACH LOAD. You may photo copy the attached "Waste Origin and Disposal Form" for future use. All waste has the potential to be redirected to the PA landfill upon discretion of the MCIA. At this time municipal type 10 waste is processed on site unless otherwise directed to the PA landfill.
- 5. If you are only tipping a single load and wish to obtain a refund of your excess deposit, contact the Finance Department at 609-278-8100.
- 6. Haulers are notified that all waste flowing through the Mercer County Improvement Authority Transfer Station MUST originate in Mercer County, NJ. If not, you should contact the agency in charge of solid waste operations for the source county of your waste.
- 7. Haulers are to maintain their deposit balances by remitting tipping fees to the Mercer County Improvement Authority each time they go through the transfer station.
- 8. All haulers will receive a monthly statement. A positive ending balance indicates that there is a net deficiency in the account. A negative figure represents an excess deposit for future-tipping fees are being held in escrow with the MCIA.

The following is an extract from The Mercer County Improvement Authority's tariff as approved by the Board of Regulatory Commissioners effective November 18, 1992.

- "....All privately-owned solid waste haulers shall be required to maintain a prepayment account with the Authority. The amount of such a prepayment account shall be based on the customer's average number of cubic yards or tons disposed of with the Authority on a twelve (12) day basis or \$250.00, whichever is greater. Required prepayment accounts must be replenished in full every five (5) days."
- "....When the Authority first requires a prepayment account from a customer, the Authority shall allow the customer to start the prepayment account by providing a six (6) day balance initially and shall not require a twelve (12) day balance until two weeks after such requirement was imposed."
- "...A late payment charge of one percent (1%) per month, calculated daily, shall be applied to the accounts of all customers who have outstanding amounts due to the Authority for solid waste disposal services rendered."

The tariff further provides:

"....The Mercer County Improvement Authority reserves the right to discontinue service (on three days notice) for the failure to make payments in accordance with the terms of this tariff and the billing statement unless other arrangements with the Mercer County Improvement Authority are made in advance."

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Act 90

On June 29, 2002 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania adopted Act 90, a law which establishes a Waste Transportation Safety Program (WTSP)

The WTSP requires owners of waste transportation vehicles with a registered weight greater than 17,000 lbs and trailers registered for more than 10,000 lbs to obtain written authorization from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP).

The WTSP prohibits in state disposal facilities from accepting waste from unauthorized vehicles after December 26, 2002.

Failure to carefully follow these instructions in accurately completing the Solid Waste Origin and Disposal Form can lead to enforcement action including penalties

Waste Type 1D.23 = vegetative waste

Waste Type ID 25 = animal and food processing waste

DIRECTIONS TO THE MCIA TRANSFER STATION

The MCIA Transfer Station is located at Dover and Stokes Avenue in Ewing Township, Mercer County, New Jersey. The main entrance is on North Olden Avenue. From Route 1 South continue onto Route 1 South (Business) to the Brunswick Circle. Take the second right turn off the circle. Go to the second traffic light and turn right, this is Spruce Street. Go to the first traffic light and turn left, this is Arctic Parkway. Go to the first traffic light and turn left, this is North Olden Avenue. Approximately 50 yards on the right is the MCIA Transfer Station.

DIRECTIONS TO TULLYTOWN/GROWS LANDFILL

The Tullytown/GROWS landfill is located at 1000 New Ford Mill Road in Falls Township, PA. After leaving the MCIA Transfer Station turn right onto North Olden Avenue. Go to the third traffic light and turn right. Follow signs onto Route 1 South. Stay on Route 1 South into Pennsylvania. Once in PA follow signs to Route 13 South. Take Route 13 South to Tyburn Road East. Take Tyburn Road East to the first traffic light, this is New Falls Road. Turn right and go to the first stop sign. At the stop sign either turn right for Tullytown Landfill or turn left for the GROWS Landfill. This is determined by which landfill is marked on the back of the MCIA weigh ticket.

FOR ALL HAULERS UTILIZING THE TULLYTOWN / GROWS LANDFILL:


INSTRUCTIONS FOR CALCULATING YOUR TOTAL DOLLARS DUE PER WASTE LOAD TIPPED:

Upon leaving the Tullytown/GROWS Landfill, all drivers have received and should bring back to their company office two (2) receipt documents for each load of waste disposed:

- One received from the MCIA Transfer Station (see SAMPLE document #1).
- One received from the Tullytown/GROWS Landfill (see SAMPLE document #2)
- To ensure accuracy, the two (2) documents should be matched utilizing the six (6) digit code found in the "TICKET" box of the MCIA document (SAMPLE #1) and on the Tullytown/GROWS document following "Haul Tk#" (SAMPLE #2).
- To calculate your total dollars due per waste load tipped, take the "RATE" found on the MCIA document (SAMPLE #1) PLUS \$7.50 (see step 1) and multiply that by the "Tons" (see step 2) found on the Tullytown/GROWS document (SAMPLE #2). The result will be the dollar amount you were charged for that load of waste and should be remitted to the MCIA within three (3) business days of the date of the waste tipped.

Repeat this procedure for EACH LOAD of waste that goes through the MCIA Transfer Station and then on to the Tullytown/GROWS Landfill for disposal.

Please be reminded that the receipt documents your drivers receives, both from the MCIA Transfer Station and from Tullytown/GROWS Landfill, are considered your invoices for services rendered and should be treated accordingly.
